The revival of VT-ALL, a Boeing 777-300 ER, marks the completion of this complex, extensive restoration effort.

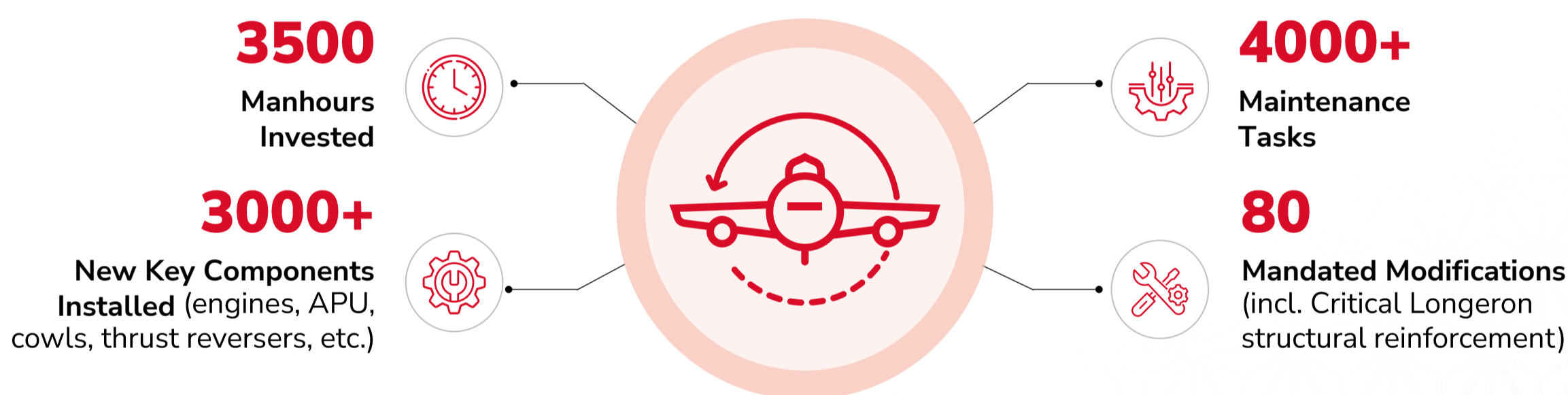


## GROUNDING SINCE FEBRUARY 2020 (~6 YEARS)

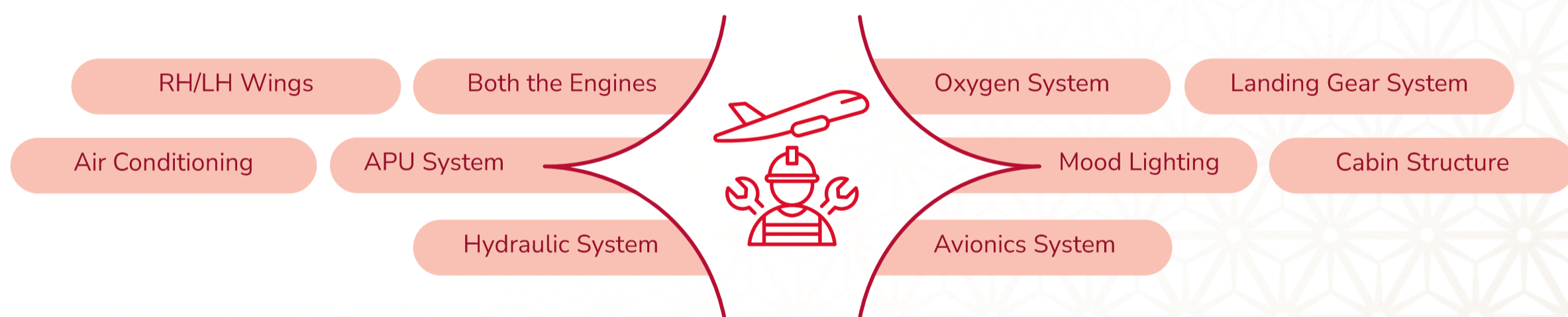


## MASSIVE RESTORATION EFFORT

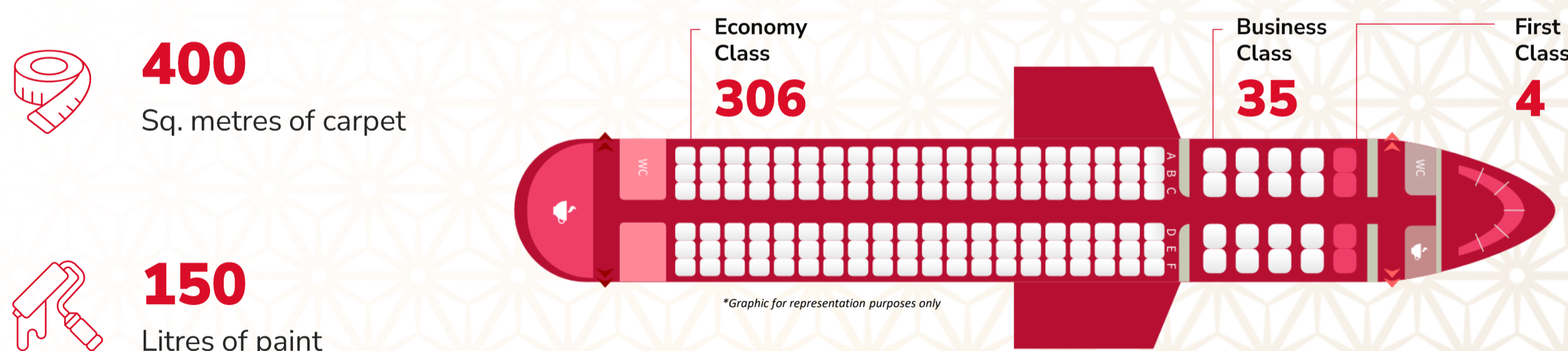

Refurbished cabin interiors, rectification of seats and Inflight Entertainment (IFE)



VT-ALL has been accorded the Airworthiness Review Certificate (ARC) - a mandatory certification to commence regular operations. It has completed its regulatory test flight and has returned to commercial service from 15 March.



VT-ALL along with other legacy B777 aircraft in our fleet, will undergo a full retrofit starting 2027 as part of a comprehensive \$400 million programme.
